

Dear Competitors:

As you can appreciate accommodating 80 boats in our harbor is a challenge, and thus the docking plan is aggressive. So, while your spot may not be as idyllic as you had hoped, we appreciate your cooperation to make this successful. Please be patient with your neighbors and courteous to our docking staff and the Harbor representatives.

Upon your arrival at StFYC/SF Marina please see the Chase StFYC Waterfront Dir. or Andre StFYC Dockmaster for gate keys and additional information.

The StFYC dock office will be open:

Saturday 9/8 – Wednesday 9/12 from 0900 to 1700

Thursday 9/13 – Sunday 9/16 from 0800 to 1900.

Shore boat service will be offered on race days from 0745 – 1000, and from the end of racing until 1900. You can hail the shore boat during these times on VHF channel 68. The shore boat pickup/drop off area will be at the easternmost end of the StFYC owned docks. To access the dock from the parking lot, use the marina gate with the large ramp adjacent to the dry storage area.

We are very fortunate to have a strong relationship with the SF City Marina. For us to continue to provide everyone berthing near the Yacht Club, please be respectful of the marina rules and other marina tenants. Do not leave any dock boxes, dehumidifiers, sails, extra equipment or trash on the dock at any time, including while racing. Please note that any boat that leaves anything on the dock will incur a \$250 fine per incident. Additionally, do not prop open the marina gates! This is number one concern of the marina staff.

Below are couple of final reminders regarding berthing at StFYC/SF Small Craft Marina

- The parking area surrounding the St. Francis Yacht Club is City owned property. Boats that have been assigned a city owned space do not come with a parking permit. Please do not park in any of the red painted spaces assigned to marina tenants or you will risk a ticket.
- Competitors who would like to keep a trailer (storage or boat) in the City parking lot must visit the Race Office immediately upon arrival for an overnight parking permit for \$8/day. Unregistered storage trailers may be ticketed and towed by the City of San Francisco. All boats and trailers will be stored at the direction of the StFYC Dockmaster or Race Coordinator.
- Trash: Remove all trash from you boat at night and make sure to secure any food down below. Raccoons would love to indulge on anything you leave out!
